

DAM, etc.

Mom: Aug 60-"No idea where to go." First visit by appraiser, 22 Sep 60. Offer of \$4600 for house 6 Dec 60. First discussion of trailer on 8 Dec 60. Papers signed 12 Dec 60, and trailer also definite. More papers signed on 9 Feb 61, and taxes and fees of \$104.50 paid. Trailer on 21 Feb 61 for \$3565. First night in trailer, 10 Jun 61. New neighbors: above, Mary PASSINGER, husband Hank (?), with sons 13, 10 and others; below, Etta Mae PASSINGER, with daughter Shirley; other neighbor Carl LARSON helped with work. Some old furniture and the lumber from the house brought about \$125. Etta Mae's brother tore the old place down.

Aug 60: Small house on ATKINS farm at Big Bend torn down in preparation for the dam. The first to go???

Nov 60: Hardware store closed.

Jan 61: Court hearing about condemned property of LILLY, BAKER (the old DONALDSON house), BARGERSTOCK, HARRIS, and SNYDER postponed two months. The ENGLISH farm was not included.

7 Feb 61: Six Kinzuaites, including LARSON and Mary ALLEN, sold houses.

Valuations vary. More offered for the MOREHOUSE place than for Ormie ENGLISH's including the little house.

May - Oct 61: Houses torn down or moved include those of T. MOORE, SHIRLEY, GERBEC, MAITLAND, KUHN, H. HANCOCK, REYNOLDS (small house), LILLY (RIEGEL), HARRIS, and Carrie FLATT, plus three back of the ME Church.

Apr 62: Rumor that the State is buying all land around the dam. This would put S. WALLACE, BARGERSTOCK, and WALTER out of their new houses, if true.

ASHWORTH: In 1960, Mom learned that her friends home at Kitts Hill, Ohio, is near Andis, not Andover.

BARGERSTOCK, Bud and Eloise: Building on top of Old State Road between Mar 61 and Aug 61. Reported in May 62 by Helen HANCOCK to have had to start tearing the old house down before the new one was ready. Lived in GOULD's in the meantime. (Saw Bud at new place Jul 62)

BROWN, Mrs: died Jul 1960.

CARPENTER, Hubert Sr (Happy): died 22 Mar 62. Lived in E. Randolph from Fall '61.
" , Hubert Jr: lived in BENNETT's old house in '60. Son Douglas 6 yrs old.

CARPENTER, John, James, David, Thomas, and Joyce: East (?) Randolph, N.Y.
" , Owen and Alice: still in Kinzua March 1962.
" , Rose: Tenn.

CATALDO, Albert: bought old DeTONTTO house (in 1960??)

HARRIS; John and Iva had been married 3 or 4 months on Election Day (8 Nov) 1960. Moved house to Stoneham in June 1961.

HAZZARD, Ardis: having house built in Lewis Run in Oct 61.

HILL, Rev.: To close store by Nov 60, move to Tidioute.

HOLT, Bernice: planning in May 62 to go to Va soon.

HURD, Dean: still in Kinzua in Mar 63.

JENKINS, Clifford, Jr.; married CLIQUIGNOT from Warren on 15 Apr 61.
" , Lawrence: died suddenly from a heart attack on 5 Nov 61. He left 6 brothers, 5 sisters, 4 children, 10 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren, 4 step-children, and 11 step-grandchildren. He was 71.

KELL, Henry: died of heart attack at 66, on 7 Nov 61.

, Stanley: twin boys, Sep 60.

, David: living on farm near Bradford, Apr 62, after marriage in Feb 62. *Back from Calif. 4/63.*

, Beatrice: on farm until sold in Feb 62. Then ??

~~KITZELING~~, Loie: rented house in Warren, early Mar 61; accepted offer in late Mar 61; moved 8 Apr 61.

KUHN, Dan: bought house on Chapman Dam Road, Clarendon, 1960.

LARSEN: sold Kinzua house Feb 61, building near Rex and Thelma that year.

LINDEBLADE; Tom: escaped from tug which sank off Norfolk in 1960. Was in the Navy from '57 to Dec '60, married in '61, son Raymond Eugene in 1962.

LYTLE, Norman: died Aug 60.

MANN, Louise: Visited Tom in '59. In '61, hoped to stay in Kinzua until Spring '62. Expected to live at YWCA ~~then~~, and to go where there is work. Living near POMPILIO in Warren, March 1963.

MANN, Tom: worked at Edwards AFB in 1960. In Oil City, Pa, Sep 64.

MARTIN, Earl: Received offer of \$2400 about Jun 62. In Russell? June 63
, Troy: Still in Kinzua, June 63. Building near Russell.

MATSON, Stuart: Moved to Virginia in 1962. He went first to work at mill, Naomi followed later. Hearing at court in Erie about property in Jun 62. Joe did not go along to Va.

MOORE, "Jake" (Clarence): received broken leg when hit by Hayes SPRINGER's car on 2 Dec 60.

MOORE, Ted: owns house in Sheffield (1960).

MORRISON, Dick: still in Kinzua end of '62. Motel north of Oil City May '63. - Sold out.

MORTON, Victor: Was offered \$4000 or \$4200 in Mar '61. Moved to Va. in '62.

NEIL, Paul: Matthews Run Road. Struck oil, in 1962? -63??

PALMIER, Rex: died of heart attack, 25 Dec 60.

PETERSON, Carl (Gabby): Youngest (in 1960) "Scotty" Edward.

On Halloween 1961, moved the little house onto the dam.

Rumored in 1961 to be building on top of Old State Road, and also to have bought a house in Tiona. In Sep 61, "may" move to land near the park on the Warren-Kinzua Road. Old HANNA house there in Feb 62, and others also by Jul 62.

Reported living in the vicinity, summer of '62; but said to be in Kinzua, Oct 62.

PETERSON, Edward: Rec'd offer of \$10,000 for the old place about Jan 61. Said to be still in Kinzua ~~Oct~~
end 62.

PETERSON, Mrs Lucy: died 30 Jan 61.

PETERSON, Ray: to live near Gabby on W-K Road (??), Sep 61. In Kinzua end of '62.

PETERSON, Ruth: to live near Gabby on W-K Road (??), Sep 61. Living in Sheffield, May 63
Said married to Don Bennett (early '63?)

POLLOCK, Joe: building near REYNOLDS in Wardletown in Jun 62.

PROSEN, Tony (?): Sep 61, reportedly planning to live near Gabby on W-K Road.

QUIGGLE, Billy: married a WELLS girl in Aug 60. Living with parents in Warren, 63.

" , Don: living near SNYDER's in 1961.

" , Merle: 1964 - International Auditing Staff of National Fuel Gas Co (Droquois Gas Corp
Has 3 children. 10 Lafayette Sq, Buffalo)

REYNOLDS, Harry: building in Wardletown, Oct 60. Accepted \$9000 for old house but that amount was later raised along with FLATT's.

SHAFER, Jack and Ginger: Home, Pa, in 1963. (March).

SHELDON, Don: Third son, no daughters, 2 Jan 61.

SHELDON, Ivan: In Va with Stu MATSON building new mill Jan-Feb 61. \$83,100 offered for old mill in Jul 61. It can operate to May 62. New mill operating in Va in May 62.

SHERMAN, McKinley: Kane. Died Jun 63, buried Russell. Dan Margie in Maine.

SHICK, : Still in Kinzua in Mar 63.

SHIPMAN, Lynn: Florida

SNOW, Charles: Decided on trailer, but not where, in Apr 61. No appraisal yet on 12 Aug 61. In May 62, moving to new home in Clarendon. (Etta Mae's brother bought the old building for \$300.)

Snow: in Kinzua on 27 May 61.

SNYDER, Jim and Bernie: bought house on Conn. St., Warren, Apr 61. Moved 15 Jun 61.

SPRINGER, Hayes: Hit Jake MOORE with a car, 2 Dec 60.

STANTON, Marshal: Clarendon

Temperature: -38° in Kinzua early Feb 61, followed by deep snow.

WALLACE, Fanny and family: in Clarendon, Dec 61.

John: died 12 Sep 62

TUTTLE, Ray Sr: \$12,000 about May 61. No word where he will go (went).

In apartment (in Warren?) Aug 62

" Jr: on farm

WALLACE, Sammy: Mar 61, planning to live on top of Old State Road. Had larger of two houses there in Aug 61. Moved end of May 62. (Saw him there Jul 62.)

WALTER, Jack and Lois: bought REYNOLDS' house and plan to have Bud WILCOX move it up the Old State Road, 1961. Got \$5600 for the old place, Oct 61.

WELLS, Don and Virginia: Virginia took Mom to vote the last time in Kinzua on 8 Nov 60. Don at mill in Va in May 62, Virginia to follow soon after.

WHITE, Gertrude: retired (in 1960??), \$8550, moved (to Youngsville??) in Oct 61.

WHITTEMORE, Louise: died at 96, on 26? Jan 62.

WILCOX, Marvin: Rumored in May 62 to be opening a store in Russell, but said to be with Ruth and Phil in Clarendon in 1963. *Store closed end Sep 62.*

WILSON, Lawrence: leaving job on oil lease, according to Helen HANCOCK, 26 May 62.

WINSLOW, Jane and Lute: moved to Clarendon with Dan KUHN, o/a 11 Nov 61.
Jane died Mar 64, buried Willow Grove.

YOUNG, Donald: 71 Dudley Drive, Bergenfield, N.J., Mar 63.
